

ACTOR'S AGREEMENT

All actors auditioning must read and commit to following these guidelines by signing below.

Because we are a community theater, all actors are expected to help with costumes, props, set construction, and all other activities involved in making a great theatrical production. Additionally, the ALT Board of Directors, along with the Goddard Center, expect that everyone involved with the show will pick up after themselves while at the theater, and following these guidelines will help make the show successful and more fun for all participants.

If cast in this show, I will make these commitments:

- I agree to be at all scheduled rehearsals, unless prearranged and approved by the Director & Stage Manager.
- I understand that I need to learn my lines by the date communicated by the Director.
- I will assist with set construction.
- My attendance at set strike is mandatory.
- I will check out and list props I need with the Stage Manager, and will advise the Stage Manager if I provide any props.
- I understand that no food or drink is allowed in the auditorium or stage area. This includes water bottles.
- I understand ALT has a no tolerance policy concerning alcohol and drugs. All actors/crew are prohibited from being on stage for any audition, rehearsal or performance while inebriated. The Director and/or Production Manager, has the authority to remove an actor or crew member if they believe the actor/crew member is inebriated.
- I agree to assist and do my part in maintaining good housekeeping in the Green Room, backstage area, and dressing rooms.
- I understand that the building is smoke-free and agree, if I smoke outside, to keep the area free of cigarette litter.
- I understand that if I bring children to the rehearsal, I will be responsible for their behavior and any damage they may cause; and will instruct them to be quiet and well behaved, and to follow the no food, no drink rules in the auditorium.
- I understand that photos and videos will be taken during auditions, rehearsals and performances for the purposes of publicity for this show and/or Ardmore Little Theatre, and I consent to use of my photo image for such purposes only.
- I understand that failure to abide by this agreement, in whole or in part, may result in my replacement in the cast for this production and may affect my chances of being cast in future productions.

Special Health and Safety Policies

The Health and Safety of our performers and crew is of the utmost priority. Please sign below your agreement with the below policies that will be required to participate.

In addition, revised protocols, rules and procedures concerning Covid-19 may be necessary to implement during rehearsals/performances due to changing national, state or local regulations.

- All performers are encouraged to wear masks at all times while inside of the theatre. If you take off your mask or gloves, they should go into a plastic bag that you take home or if disposable, place them directly into a trash can. Do not cross contaminate surfaces by setting down used masks or gloves anywhere.
- We will take temperatures with a no touch thermometer at the backstage door.
- Use hand sanitizer or wash your hands thoroughly upon entering the theatre.
- There will be stations of hand sanitizer, Kleenex, Lysol and wipes throughout the theatre. Please use these items to clean up after yourself.
- ALT is a community theatre, which means **all actors** are expected to help with the cleaning, keeping things picked up, trash taken out, dressing rooms/restrooms cleaned, etc... So if you think something is not clean enough, then please clean it. All cleaning products will be readily available in each of the dressing rooms and in the shop.
- ALT is only to be in **the auditorium, green room/dressing rooms and the backstage area** during rehearsals. **The front foyer and front restrooms are OFF LIMITS!** The Goddard Center has the front foyer and restrooms cleaned and sanitized at the end of day in preparation for the next day events. Please be considerate of the other people and groups using the Goddard Center and stay out of the front area. With all the new cleaning/sanitizing procedures, we really need to stay in our areas so we don't make extra work for others.
